GENERALITIES

The wines « En Champs » resemble those of the neighbouring climate of « Champeaux ». Exposed to the sunrise, on a gentle slope, this climate classified as « village » produces a superb Gevrey.

Vine variety: Pinot noir

Surface area: 330 hectares of which 51 hectares extend into the village of

Brochon

Altitude: 240 to 280 meters

Soil: Sandy marls

OUR PLOT

Planted in 1959, it is situated in Gevrey-Chambertin, in the heights of the village, between Gevrey-Chambertin et Brochon. Its area is estimated at 0,3 hectare.
